Supplies

Please bring a camp chair and each Unit should bring a folding table or two if possible. If it is drizzly, you may want to also bring a canopy. The Scouts will need a table to assemble their rockets. For each participating scout, please bring 5 empty 20oz plastic soda bottles (Mountain Dew bottles are the sturdiest plastic) and 1 empty 2-liter soda bottle.

Lunch will not be provided so please bring a packed lunch.

Parking

Weekend parking for ALL vehicles will be at the fairgrounds. Parking attendants will assist with parking arrangements on the day of arrival.

Directions

From Cumberland, take Canal Parkway to WV State Route 28. Follow for 10 miles. Cross the Memorial Bridge at Patterson's Creek. The fairgrounds will be on the left. Use the second entrance (past the fenced area).

From Keyser, take WV State Route 46 to the intersection of WV State Route 28. Turn left at the stop light. Travel approx. ½ mile to the fairgrounds on the right. Take the first entrance.

From Romney, follow WV State Route 28 to Fort Ashby. Go straight through the stoplight. Travel approx. ½ mile to the fairgrounds on the right. Take the first entrance.
